1. Physical distancing

• What will be done to implement physical distancing guidelines?

Consider: physical distancing for staff and patrons; occupancy limits based on 2sqm requirements; management of waiting areas etc.

Peel Hockey has considered the return to training and competition guidelines in 3 phases (attached) - Planning. Preparation and Operation.

- Planning - key decisions, communication (with clubs and participants), facility management and pre-start training (infection control) and games.
 - Preparation - installation of distancing measures, facility audit / training readiness, management arrangements and cleaning / hygiene and sanitation.
 - Operations - pre and post training and game checks / tasks, as well as during training management.
- Peel Hockey has developed a Rules and Protocols doco that will be sent to all clubs and participants prior to the return to training and games.
- In addition, training groups will have staggered start / finish times and separate entry / exits.

2. Hygiene

• How will you ensure required hygiene standards are maintained?

Consider: hygiene protocols and practices; supply of cleaning and sanitiser products etc.

Peel Hockey has installed additional hygiene facilities and undertake cleaning before, after and in between training groups and games.

3. Training and education

- How will you ensure all your workers know how to keep themselves and others safe from exposure to COVID-19?

Consider: staff training; records of training; additional education; signage; guidance material etc.

All board members, staff and coaches will be required complete COVID infection control training prior to returning to training and games commencement.

Staff have been educated in physical distancing and will be provided with all necessary PPE.
