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### TURF MAINTENANCE:

- To ensure that the turf is kept in good condition it is essential that all personnel wash the soles of their shoes by stepping into the water tray when entering. Do not jump fence to enter or leave playing arena.
- Health regulations stipulate that appropriate sporting foot wear must be worn at all time on the turf. This means no bare feet or thongs allowed.
- No glass, chewing gum, cans, metal or alcohol is permitted within the playing arena.

### TRAINING:

- Goal practice should be done on the furthest side of the field, closest to old shed.
- No training or pre-game hit ups in goal playing circles.
- **Please be courteous to all fellow hockey players and clubs by respecting each other's training sessions** by not entering the field until your allocated time and exiting promptly at the end of your session.
- Clubs/teams please advise your members that they cannot use the turf unless the club has booked a training timeslot.
  - In most cases the gate will be locked until ½hr before the first evening training session and if required the turf will be watered at this time.
  - It is essential that players do not commence to warm up on the turf if the field has yet to be watered or is in the process of being watered.
- Cancellation of training times must be received by the Administrator 48hrs before training is scheduled. Email advice is sufficient provided it is sent by an executive member of the Club. Late cancellation may incur a fee.
- If your club is going to cancel a training timeslot temporarily or permanently, the **latest timeslot must be cancelled**.
- Players/Clubs damaging the facility will be required to pay for any repairs carried out. If you see an area that is damaged, please report it.
- Please remove training tyres from the turf when finished.

### NO SMOKING VENUE:

This means the **TOTAL AREA** from the car park footpath, includes entrance to the stadium, Halls Head Community College and Halls Head Community Recreation Centre is a non-smoking venue at all times (24hrs/7days).

### LICENSED PREMISES:

- **No alcohol is to be brought into or taken from the stadium.** Alcohol must be consumed within the designated area - area starts at the entrance gate and includes the main hall, concourse and seating. **The licensed area does not include the paved and grassed areas surrounding the turf.**
- Persons under 18 are not permitted to consume alcohol.
- It is an offence to buy alcohol for a minor, any person seen supplying alcohol to a minor will be asked to leave the premises.
- Before leaving, please ensure that your rubbish (food scraps, cans, bottles etc) are put in the rubbish bins provided. Cans to be placed in the "cans only" container near entrance fence. This also applies to change rooms – thankyou.

### MAIN HALL:

- We would like to see everyone utilising this room more during the season. Tables and chairs are available and purchasing of food & drinks can be done through the opening into the hall. This room will not be opened all the time, so please ask if you wish to use it.
- The main hall is a licensed area. Children are not permitted in this room unless supervised by an adult.

### OTHER:

- **CHILDREN ARE NOT ALLOWED IN DUGOUTS ON GAME DAY OR DURING TRAINING.**
- **NO ANIMALS ARE ALLOWED ON THE PREMISES**
