It is important that anyone working in the food industry, handling or selling food for charity or community events, makes sure food sold is safe and suitable to eat.

All food businesses have a legal responsibility to comply with the Food Act 2008 (external site), Food Regulations 2009 (external site) and the Australia New Zealand Food Standards Code (external site) including Chapter 3; Food Safety Standards (external site).

All Volunteers assisting in the Stadium Canteen MUST have completed the Food Safe Food Handling Training Program.

The Food Safe Food Handling course is provided FREE for Canteen volunteers by the City of Mandurah and takes less than an hour to complete online.

All Volunteers assisting in the Stadium Canteen MUST have completed the Food Safe Food Handling Training Program and have turned 14 years of age and be mature enough to service patrons (children & adults) from canteen window.

Duties include:

- Taking orders
- Use of POS (Point of Sale) tablet
- Cash handling proficient enough to give correct change.
- Use of EFTPOS machine
- Capable of working with deep fryer (hot chip orders)

- Monday evenings 5pm to 7pm
- Tuesday evenings 4pm to 7pm
- Friday evenings 5pm to 7.30pm, occasionally to 9.00pm
- Weekends either or both
