Club Championships are a 3-day event organised by Hockey WA, catering for a gender specific age group with a focus on recognising the “champions” for the tournament. Teams travel from all over the state to participate in a number of games consisting of 2 x 20 minute halves, played on both grass and turf, with finals & crossover games played on the last day.

Hockey WA are calling for team nominations in the following school year age groups:

- 9/10 Girls** – Monday 4<sup>th</sup> July to Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> July
- 9/10 Boys** – Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> July to Friday 8<sup>th</sup> July
- 7/8 Girls** – Monday 11<sup>th</sup> July to Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> July
- 7/8 Boys** – Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> July to Friday 15<sup>th</sup> July

***Players must nominate for teams to be created for nomination to the competition. (No Players = No Team)***

This competition is organised by Hockey WA and participants are recommended to possess a high level of skill and experience. Should enough players nominate for 2 teams, then 2 teams shall be nominated, provided that they are deemed viable by having a Coach, Manager and Umpire for both teams.

The maximum number of players per team is 16, should more than 16 players nominate but less than 26 (minimum required for 2 teams) then a player trial/selection process maybe be called by the Junior Committee.

**Volunteers**

All teams require 1 x Coach, 1 x Team Manager & 1 x Umpire to be deemed viable for nomination into the Carnival competition.

## Venue

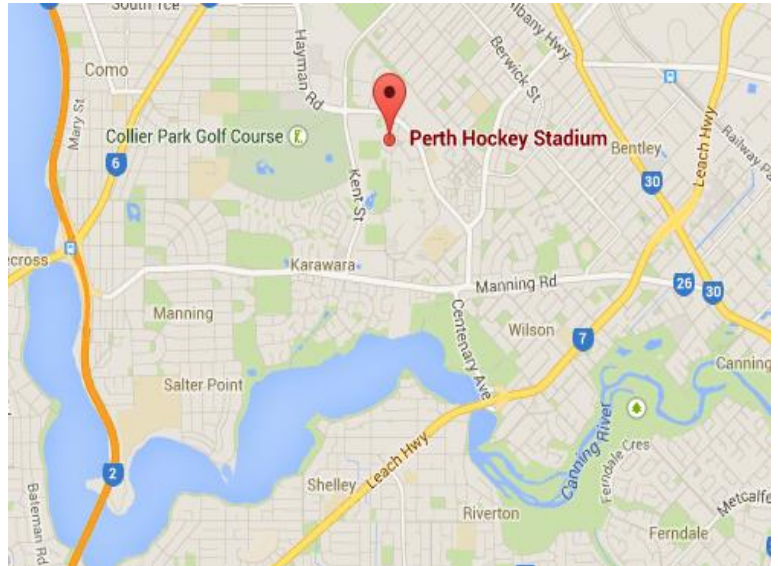

Select Sport Hockey shop is also available on site.

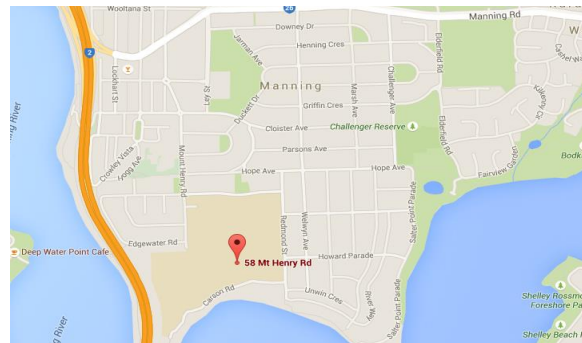


## Aquinas Turf
